

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR FUMIGATION ACTIVITIES – REV.04

In order to ensure the safety of all personnel, as well as the environment preservation and protection, PORTONAVE informs the minimum requirements for registration and authorization for companies interested to perform fumigation activities inside its facilities.

Interested companies must provide to PORTONAVE:

- Municipal License;
- Sanitary License;
- Environmental Authorization for the application of agrochemicals in storage environments;
- Company's Operating Authorization - ANVISA;
- Certificate of accreditation – MAPA;
- Federal Technical Registry - IBAMA;
- Certificate of Regularity – IBAMA;
- Technical Responsibility Register – ART of the company responsible person;
- CREA or CRQ Certificate of Regularity;
- Environment Risk Prevention Program – PPRA (NR 09);
- Medical Control and Occupational Health Program - PCMSO (NR 07);
- Occupational Health Certificate;
- EPI delivery form for each worker who will carry out the activity;
- Material Safety Data Sheet - MSDS of the products used; e
- Operators' training registers to perform fumigation activity.

NOTE.1: *Workers must attend PORTONAVE's safety briefing program (valid for 01 (one) year).*

NOTE.2: *Minimum Personal Protection Equipment to access the terminal are: Safety helmet + chin straps; safety glasses; safety shoes; high reflective clothes or jacket.*

IMPORTANT: *The interested companies are responsible to maintain all documentation properly updated. In the absence of any mentioned document, PORTONAVE can refuse the access to until the documents are provided.*
